



## Top 10 Most Asked Questions and Answers

- 1. What are the school hours?**  
8:00 a.m. – 2:45 p.m. (K & 1<sup>st</sup>), 8:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. (2<sup>nd</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup>)
- 2. Do you offer a gifted program?**  
We do not offer a gifted program. Beginning in the 2013-2014 school year, our school has been approved for the Cambridge Program which will be offered in 3<sup>rd</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> grades to qualifying students. Along with this exciting curriculum addition, we offer a Guaranteed and Viable Curriculum which is aligned to specific Next Generation Sunshine State Standards and is the framework of what is taught at each grade level.
- 3. Is there a wait list?**  
Open enrollment for our current students and their siblings begins in January, after which spots will be available on a first-come, first serve basis. There will be a wait list for all students not enrolled at time of registration.
- 4. What is the dress code?**  
We do require school uniforms to be worn by all students. Uniforms are to be purchased through our approved school uniform provider only. Navy or khaki bottoms (shorts, pants, skirts) with the embroidered school logo and red embroidered polo shirts (K-5), blue or white embroidered polo shirts (6-8).
- 5. Do you provide transportation?**  
We offer transportation if your address is within 2 miles from the school and are deemed to be within the walking hazard zone. You will be notified if you are eligible for the bus after enrollment. The seating is limited and is on a first come, first serve basis.
- 6. Do you have Before Care and After Care?**  
We offer Before Care starting at 6:45 a.m. and After Care until 6:00 p.m. Please see the Before/After Care Handbook for fee details.
- 7. What kind of extra-curricular activities do you have?**  
We offer a variety of after school clubs which are supervised and directed by our teachers. Some of the current offerings include: Art, Basketball, Cheer, Drama, Guitar, Film/Media, Music, Soccer, and Volleyball Clubs.
- 8. Do we provide free and reduced lunches?**  
Yes, free and reduced lunches are offered to parents who meet the eligibility requirements.
- 9. What is the cost of lunch and breakfast?**  
The cost for breakfast is \$1.50 and lunch is \$2.85. Our school does participate in the National School Lunch Program.

10. **How can I get volunteer hours?**

Parents are required to complete at least 20 hours of volunteer hours. Parents are eligible to volunteer after they have registered at the school office and have been approved through the Palm Beach County School District's VIPS system. This process can take between 4 – 6 weeks for the background check and final approval. Once approved, parents can sign up with our volunteer coordinator for volunteer hours in our cafeteria, clinic, drop-off and pick-up car loop, field trips, and teacher copy services.
